2. For liability reasons neither the Coaches, nor any Reagan Lacrosse Association Board Member will offer to provide transportation to any player.
3. On any occasions that overnight travel will be required to participate in any Reagan Lacrosse Association events, neither the Coaches, nor any Reagan Lacrosse Association Board Member will offer to chaperone any player overnight.
4. On any occasions that overnight travel will be required to participate in any Reagan Lacrosse Association events, neither the Coaches, nor any Reagan Lacrosse Association Board Member will be responsible for the actions of any player while not on the playing field.

As a player for the Reagan Lacrosse Association team, you are given privileges as well as responsibilities. You are also given the opportunity to represent your team with the highest honor and pride.

You have the responsibility to show each team we encounter the ideals of what we represent. With this commitment comes the responsibility of YOURSELF. You are responsible for your behavior ON AND OFF the field.

Your responsibility for yourself includes the careful handling of your Lacrosse uniforms. These uniforms are expensive and difficult to replace as a complete matching set.

You will be assigned home and away uniforms to be used by you during the spring season. The uniform will consist of one pair of Game Shorts and two Game Jerseys. **NEW THIS YEAR - THERE IS A UNIFORM RENTAL FEE REQUIRED OF EACH PLAYER IN THE AMOUNT OF \$50.00 DUE AND PAYABLE TO REAGAN LACROSSE ASSOCIATION FOR USE OF THE UNIFORM FOR THE SEASON.**

These uniforms must be treated carefully and kept clean. The Association expects that once a uniform is worn in game play it will be laundered prior to the next use.

As a player, I know that I am also responsible to bring my clean uniforms to each game.

Every Player is required to return the complete uniforms at the end of the season in good condition or the Player will forfeit the Uniform Security Deposit Check provided at the beginning of the season.

Reagan Lacrosse 2010-2011

Participation in the Reagan High School Lacrosse Program is a privilege that carries both honors and responsibilities for athletes, coaches and parents. Adherence to the following code of conduct will help to ensure a positive, rewarding experience for all involved.

ATHLETES

- Reagan Lacrosse athletes will display positive moral, academic and leadership qualities.
- Reagan Lacrosse athletes will show respect to officials, coaches and teammates on and off the field.
- Reagan Lacrosse athletes will abide by all area school district rules concerning personal appearance and grooming, including travel to and from all club related activities.
- Reagan Lacrosse athletes will not use obscene or vulgar language, intentionally violate rules, use illegal tactics or resort to displays of ill temper on or off the playing field.
- Reagan Lacrosse athletes **will not** openly dispute, argue with, embarrass or challenge the judgment of the official. Discussions with officials concerning the game shall only involve the team head coach or the designate team captain.
- Reagan Lacrosse athletes will exhibit sportsman like conduct at all time, winning with honor, and losing graciously.
- Reagan Lacrosse athletes will attend practices and games unless receiving prior permission for the Coaching staff.
- Reagan Lacrosse athletes will refrain from using alcohol, tobacco and illegal drugs at all times.

COACHES

- Reagan Lacrosse coaches will be expected to adhere to the requirements of behavior asked of the athletes.
- Reagan Lacrosse coaches will strive to be proficient and knowledgeable in all aspects of the game of lacrosse in order to provide proper and skillful instruction to their athletes.
- Reagan Lacrosse coaches will be expected to enact non-partial disciplinary action towards any athlete not abiding by the athlete's "Code of Conduct."
- Reagan Lacrosse coaches will not openly dispute, argue with, embarrass or challenge the judgment of the official. Discussions with officials concerning the game shall only involve the team head coach or the designate team captain.

PARENTS

- Reagan Lacrosse parents will be expected to adhere to the requirements of behavior asked of the athletes.
- Reagan Lacrosse parents will provide positive support and encouragement for the athletes
- Reagan Lacrosse parents will display proper sportsmanship to Reagan's opponents and spectators.

- Reagan Lacrosse parents will not openly dispute, argue with, embarrass or challenge the judgment of the game officials. Discussions with officials concerning the game shall only involve the team coach or the designate team captain.
- Reagan Lacrosse parents will not openly dispute, argue with, embarrass or challenge the on-field judgment of the coaches. Discussions concerning coaching issues shall only involve the boys' high school program director.

For Players: Disciplinary action for violations for the Reagan Lacrosse "Code of Conduct" will be in line with the area's High School "Student Code of Conduct" up to and including dismissal from the team.

For Parents: Failure to comply with the Reagan Lacrosse "Code of Conduct" can result in ejection from the field or being banned from games or your child being removed from the program.
